Dear Badger League Player,

I would like to thank you for your support and for choosing Deer Valley as your league home. Some of you have played in the Badger League since its inception, and many have joined along the way. I would like to take this time to thank you for your support and business! As in the past, you will find a specially priced promo round coupon on the sign-up sheet for some practice before league starts- simply a Thank You for all of your support. I ask that you call or e-mail your desire to play as soon as possible. Should you not be playing this year, please let us know that as well.

2010 was an enjoyable year for golf at Deer Valley. While Mother Nature helped keep us green, I am happy with the way our upgraded irrigation performed and am excited about the reception the Valley Course received. I am looking forward to an even better 2011 and the continued maturity of Deer Valley! This past Fall we have worked on a number of projects on the course including planting more trees, widened and seeded some of the narrow landing areas on the Valley Course, digging up and leveling fairway sprinkler heads and we have completed a total overhaul of the 2 lower teeing grounds on hole #5 to make the entire teeing ground level and useable. We will also be trading in some of our older carts and replacing them with new ones, something we plan to continue each year.

For league play, the Deer Valley staff will again do all average keeping, league standings, scorecards, and match handicapping- you just need to show up and play golf! **WSGA computerized handicap service will again be offered at a discount to full time league players (\$25).** As in the past, you can find league standings, schedules and averages on our website: www.deervalleygolf.com and we will continue to e-mail weekly updates.

The information sheet in this packet outlines the basic league set-up for this year. The format will remain the same with 2-man teams competing against each other for nightly points and the weekly point system will also remain the same as outlined in the league info sheet. Last year we had 12 teams and hope to grow the league by 4-6 teams this year. To help do that we are offering a referral bonus program that is highlighted in the info sheet below- please let me know if there is anyone you know who might be interested in Badger League play and I will personally contact them.

The fee for sign-up is outlined in the information sheet- It has increased \$1 to reflect the \$1 increase in the league green fee. While all other cart rates are now plus tax, league and member cart rates remain tax inclusive and unchanged. We hope you still find the cost of \$13 for 9 holes of golf and Deer Valley service a good value. Full, senior and weekday members pay \$39 to sign-up and pay no green fees for the season. Please consider our club events that are open to members, associate members, and full time league players with a DV WSGA Handicap- they are there for you!

The deadline for verbal team commitment is April 5th and a call to the course or an e-mail is sufficient. The sign-up fee deadline is Tuesday April 12th at 6:00, which is also the date and time of the league meeting. At the meeting I will answer questions and hope to hand out schedules. We can also discuss any rule or policy questions that you, as a group would like changed. League play will begin on April 19th.

I look forward to seeing all of you again, you all have played an important role in the growth of Deer Valley G.C. and we greatly appreciate it! If you know of any players who are interested in league, or know past players who have not given me their address, please have them contact me for materials. Thank you again for your past and continued support of Deer Valley Golf Course. Feel free to contact me with any questions, comments, or concerns.

DEER VALLEY BADGER

2011 Golf League

- DATES** 18 consecutive Tuesdays beginning April 19th. Days deemed as rainouts by the golf professional will be made up at the end of regular season play before playoffs. Tee times will run from 4:48 through 5:44 based on 16 teams.
- FORMAT** This league will consist of 2-man teams. Teams will play match play against each other consisting of two separate individual matches where the two higher average players compete against each other and the two lower average players compete against each other. It is your responsibility to find a sub if you can't make it. If your opponent does not show or fails to get a sub (substitutes are the player's responsibility) you will play against that person's average +10% - **no free points- No Shows receive 0 Points!**
- POINTS** There will again be a 18 point system per team match. 1 point will be awarded for each hole won (tied holes will give each player ½ point). Matches will be handicapped based on 80% of the stroke differential between opponents with no requirement to finish a hole once someone is beaten
18 possible points per 2 man team per night
- AVERAGES** Players will begin the season where their average was at the end of last year. New players will start by setting average while playing. Averages throughout the season will only be based on your last 4 rounds with previous scores eliminated.
- FEES** **TOTAL SIGN-UP COST IS \$52**
This fee includes the last night of league green fee(\$13), league championship prizes(\$25), League Food Night (\$8) and \$6 for special prizes for all during playoff weeks. Full, senior and weekday members subtract \$13 and pay \$39.
- SIGN-UP** ***Deadline for verbal commitment is April 5th , fee payment deadline is Tuesday , April 12th***. Please include your league fee check with your entry form- There will be a league meeting on April 12th at Deer Valley at 6:00 p.m. and I will go over league rules, hand out schedules, and answer any questions you may have.

BADGER LEAGUE GENERAL RULES

1. PLEASE COUNT YOUR STROKES ACCURATELY
2. IF SOMEONE GIVES YOU A PUTT, YOU MUST COUNT THAT AS A STROKE
3. THIS LEAGUE PLAYS WINTER RULES THROUGH THE GREEN
 - a. **YOU MAY MOVE YOUR BALL 12 INCHES NO NEARER THE HOLE WITHOUT GOING FROM ROUGH TO FAIRWAY, FAIRWAY TO GREEN, ETC.**
 - b. **YOU MAY NOT MOVE YOUR BALL IN SAND, OR RED STAKED HAZARD AREAS**
4. RED STAKED AND LONG GRASS AREAS ARE NOT OUT OF BOUNDS, THEY ARE CONSIDERED A LATERAL HAZARD, PROCEED AS FOLLOWS:
 - a. **EXCEPT FOR THE RIGHT OF #12, AND RIGHT OF #13 YOU CAN PLAY IT BUT IF YOU DO YOU CANNOT:**
 1. LET YOUR CLUB TOUCH THE GROUND WHEN YOU ARE TAKING YOUR STANCE BUT YOU CAN HIT THE GROUND IN YOUR SWING
 2. MOVE ANY STICKS, GRASS OR ROCKS
 3. IMPROVE YOUR LIE
 4. **IF YOU HIT IN THE HAZARD ON #12, OR #13 YOU MAY NOT PLAY IT, YOU MUST DROP OUT OF THAT AREA- GREEN TOPPED STAKES (TAKE A 1 STROKE PENALTY)**
 - b. **DROP YOUR BALL WITHIN 2 CLUBLENGTHS OF WHERE YOUR BALL CROSSED THE RED HAZARD LINE- NOT EVEN TO WHERE YOUR BALL ENDED UP- ONE STROKE PENALTY**
 - c. **IF ON HOLES 5, 6, AND 13 YOU MAY DROP ON THE DROP AREA- ONE STROKE PENALTY**
5. **THE ONLY OUT OF BOUNDS ON THE COURSE IS THE FENCE ON HOLES 2 AND 3- YOU MUST HIT ANOTHER BALL UNDER 1 STROKE PENALTY AND LOSS OF DISTANCE FROM THE SAME SPOT.**
6. **CART PATHS, SPLIT RAIL FENCES, AND GAZEBOS ARE OBSTRUCTIONS- FREE RELIEF OF SWING ONLY -2 CLUBLENGTHS NO NEARER THE HOLE**
7. **PLEASE TOTAL ALL SCORES WHEN FINISHED AND TURN IN THE CARD**
8. **RAIN POLICY**
 - a. **IF THE LAST GROUP OF LEAGUE FINISHES THE 6TH HOLE BEFORE CANCELLATION OF PLAY IT IS CONSIDERED AN OFFICIAL NIGHT AND REMAINING HOLES WILL SPLIT POINTS- WE WILL CALCULATE A TOTAL STROKES SCORE USING THE WSGA GUIDELINES**
 - b. **IF THE LAST GROUP DOES NOT FINISH THE 6TH HOLE, THE ENTIRE LEAGUE IS CONSIDERED A RAINOUT AND WILL BE MADE UP AT THE END OF THE REGULAR SCHEDULE BEFORE PLAYOFFS**
 - c. **DECISIONS TO CANCEL LEAGUE WILL BE MADE BY 3:30**
9. **SUBSTITUTES ARE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY, PLEASE INFORM US WELL IN ADVANCE**
 - a. **SUBSTITUE RULES AND GUIDELINES The substitute will always take the place of the person he is subbing for, no matter if his average is higher or lower than his partner's. eg. Bill's ave. is 40, his partner's ave. is 45. Bill is scheduled to play the lowest ave. on the other team. Bill gets a sub, the sub's ave. is 46. Even though the sub's ave. is higher than his partner's, he will play Bill's scheduled opponent**
10. **POINTS- THERE ARE 9 POSSIBLE POINTS PER PLAYER.**

MATCHES ARE PLAYED AT 80% OF THE STROKE DIFFERENTIAL-ONE POINT WILL BE AWARDED FOR EACH HOLE WON AND ½ FOR EACH HOLE TIED.
11. **NO SHOWS: IF YOUR OPPONANT DOESN'T SHOW YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE FREE POINTS. YOU WILL PLAY AGAINST THE NO-SHOW'S AVERAGE +10% E.G. THE NO SHOW'S AVERAGE IS 40 AND YOUR AVERAGE IS 40. YOU WILL PLAY THE NO SHOW EVEN BUT THE NO SHOW WILL POST A SCORE OF 44(+10%) WITH AN EXTRA SHOT ADDED ON THE 4 TOUGHEST HOLES GIVING THE PERSON WHO SHOWS UP A DISTINCT ADVANTAGE BUT NO "FREE" POINTS**

NEW- A NO SHOW WILL RECEIVE NO POINTS
12. **LATE ARRIVALS: IF YOU ARRIVE TO THE TEE AFTER ANYONE IN YOUR GROUP HAS HIT THEIR 2ND SHOT YOU WILL INCUR A 2 STROKE PENALTY. IF YOU ARRIVE AFTER THEY HAVE FINISHED THE FIRST HOLE YOU WILL LOSE THAT HOLE AND LOSE THE TOTAL STROKES POINTS BUT CAN STILL COMPETE FOR HOLE POINTS**
13. **PLAYOFF SUBSTITUTES-**
 1. **SUBSTITUTES FOR PLAYOFF MATCHES MUST HAVE PLAYED AT LEAST 2 ROUNDS IN ANY DV LEAGUE THROUGHOUT THE SEASON**
 2. **EMPLOYEES OF DEER VALLEY MAY NOT SUB IN PLAYOFF MATCHES. IF THEY ARE A REGULAR LEAGUE PLAYER, THEY CERTAINLY MAY PLAY ON THEIR OWN TEAM FOR PLAYOFFS**
